
Set your hot water tap temperature to 50°C	\$115

Wash laundry at 30°C instead of 40/60°C	£20

Make five simple changes to the way you cook at home

Use the most efficient cooking appliance	£202
Batch cook when possible	£112
Use the right size pan with a lid	£51
Simmer rather than boil	£48
Avoid over-filling the kettle	£13


